Project: "Delicate Spiral" designed by Miwako Nara
Resource: Beadwork Magazine February/March 2006 page 30.

Supplies needed:

Two grams size 11 seed beads
Five grams size 3 (12 MM) bugles, I used a twisted bugle
One focal bead
Clasp
Beading thread.....I used 6 lb test fireline
Beading needle

Note: The instructions in the magazine are Very confusing. I tried it on my own and had problems. Fortunately I hooked up with Tammy Coker at the bead faire and she showed me a visual instruction in two minutes flat. Easy as pie and fun to do.
