At the Nov 7 meeting we will begin the base of this bracelet it will take some time to complete this part. So bring your 40 g size 6 seed beads. The color of crystals and seed beads do not have to exactly match the base of the bracelet it will not be seen when wearing.

Complete Supplies list is:

200 4mm bicone crystals (I made one with 4mm and another with 6mm both worked)

40g size 6 seed beads

30g size 11 seed beads

½ in (1.3cm) button for clasp

NymoD r Fireline 6 lb test

Beading needles, #10

Any other supplies you normally use.

Bracelet 7 ½ in (19.1 cm)

48 4mm Czech round or fire-polished glass beads

8 g size 11 Japanese seed beads, in each of 4 colors

Clasp

Nymo B conditioned with beswax, or SoNo beading thread

Beading needles, #12 or #13

And Any other beading supplies you normally use.
