At Schuterman-Benson Library 10:00am – 4:00pm Cost \$10.00

You will need to bring all your own supplies.

Tools Ruler, Round nose, Flat nose pliers and Wire Cutters

Wire Twister, End rounder, File

20 G full hard round STERLING WIRE

18 G round dead soft STERLING WIRE

21 G square dead soft STERLING WIRE

2 beads for pair of earrings with the 20 G wire.

(If you have not purchased the wire there is a supply at Island Dream Beads stop by and see the selection.)

PROGRAMS

This is a right angle weave bracelet made with size 6 seeds

The size 12 seeds will be to embellish the bracelet.

You will need to bring

1 large tube size 6 seed beads (4 colors if possible)

1 large tube size 12 seed beads for accent beads

threading material (fireline, nymo your choice)

needle, clasp and other supplies you normally use.

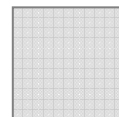
